God's message of hope for you

I. Even if you are an upright Christian, you will have 'dark nights'

A. Joseph's life is an example of this: an upright man in a dark night (18)

B. Learn to embrace James 1:2-4:

My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations

II. If you meet setbacks following God, know God is sharpening you up!

A. Joseph already was a gem, but God polished him by His providences (vs. 19)

- B. God still uses trials as His instruments to change you for the better (24-25)
 - 1. Scripture's gives plenty example
 - 2. Pray for grace to embrace God's providential setbacks or trials a. some are to correct you (Hebrews 12:7-13)
 - b. some are to grow you (Romans 8:28-29)
- C. Our solid *hope* is that God is in control of every detail

III. In your darkest moments God may reveal His most precious hope!

A. Joseph's heart is first set at ease with God's revelation: vs. 20

- B. Next God floods Joseph's heart with most comforting revelation: vs. 21-23
 - 1. Here shame drained away from his heart
 - 2. Here comfort flowed into his heart
