THOUGH STORMS ARE FEARFUL, IF YOU FOLLOW JESUS IN FAITH, YOU NEED NOT BE AFRAID

## I. As you live on this earth, you cannot avoid troubles in your life

- A. When we left God, we stepped into a stormy land: Gen. 3:17-19
- B. Therefore you will not avoid storms, trials, sufferings: Job 5:7; 14:1-5

#### II. But even if you follow Jeus, you will also not avoid storms


- A. Jesus' disciples obeyed Him and took Him onto the lake: Mark 4:35-36
- B. Their experience teaches: Following Jesus may not mean smooth sailing!

#### III. If you meet storms following Jesus, He is strengthening your trust in Him

- A. Jesus' disciples struggle with stormy waters and a sleeping Jesus (37-38)
- B. Jesus' disciples are overtaken by their fears (38) but saved (39, 41)
- C. If Jesus is so powerful to stop storms, why will He not prevent storms?
  - 1. Because He knows storms build your faith to be like His (vs. 38a)
  - 2. Because His wisdom knows storms makes you need Him more (vs. 38b)
  - 3. Because He His knows your faith only grows when you use it (vs. 40, 41)

**Wrap up**: Don't fear the storms if you faithfully follow and trust Jesus!

- A. Storms come but not by chance!
- B. Storms can make you afraid but may not make you despair!
- C. Storms are Jesus' methods to draw your closer to Him!
