THE BRIDEGROOM DECLARES HIS COMMITMENT TO YOU HIS CHOSEN BRIDE

I. He is not committed to you because you are worthy

- A. Gomer is the most lovely and unworthy spouse (Hos. 1-2)
 - 1. Before marriage and after marriage she was impure and unfaithful
 - 2. Sadly this is still true in many of God's children: 1 John 2:15; James 4:4
- B. Yet the LORD God is committed to His people even when they sin
 - 1. Gomer was ignorant of His care:
 - a. in His barriers to stop her (vs. 6)
 - b. in His care over her (vs. 8)
 - c. in His tough love to bring her back (vs. 9-13)
 - 2. His sole goal: to allure back into sweet communion with Him
 - a. the 'wilderness' is a return 'time of days of her youth' (14, 15)
 - b. the door of hope in dark valley of Achor (15)
 - c. the restoring of the relationship (16-17)
 - 3. Then what He added was even more to allure: I will betroth thee ...

II. He is committed to you because of His eternal & gracious covenant

- A. He reminds you of the future promises: harmony and security (vs. 18, 21-23)
- B. He reminds us of His abiding covenant commitment (19-20)
 - 1. No new covenant but a restored and deepened covenant (Jer. 31:31-34)
- C. He allures all His backsliding Gomers married to Him by repentance and faith!
 - 1. He allures with His promise to share His comfortable words with you! (14)
 - 2. He allures with His promise to 'betroth thee unto Him' (19)
 - 3. He allures with the most glorious marriage vow ever spoken (19-20)
