

LET'S THINK: What is the most staggering Bible truth that man never could think?

God fulfilled His promise to send His only Son to be your Redeemer

- I. God sent forth the Redeemer of the devil's subject as He promised
- A. God did so 'when the fulness of the time was come' (Gal. 4:4a)
- B. Why did He wait for 4000 yrs to bring the Redeemer to crush Satan?
- II. What God did in the fulness of time is to bow your knees forever before Him!
- A. God sent forth **His Son**: John 1:14, 18; 3:16, 18; Romans 8:32
- B. God sent forth His Son made of a woman: CoF art 18-19)
 - 1. No child except this One is a 'son of a woman'
 - 2. He did not come like the *pre-fall* Adam: Rom. 8:3
 - 3. He came to 'learn' by suffering our infirmities (Heb. 2)
 - 4. He came as 'real human' with soul and body
- (C. God sent forth His Son **under the law** (explore in art. 20-21))
 LET'S REFLECT: Why did God the Father send His Son into our human nature?
 A. So He can be your best Counselor-Helper: Heb. 2:17-18; 4:15-16
- B. Do you ask: What must I do then?
 - 1. You must make up your mind!
 - 2. You must repent and humble yourself before Jesus!
 - 3. You must commit yourself to Jesus Christ alone!
