I. The Believer's Reflection about what Jesus did

- A. No human is able to relieve an awakened and humbled sinner
- B. But the Shulamite's reflection testified that Jesus can: He brought me...
 - 1. This tribute exalts the glories of the Lord
 - 2. How did He bring her into this wealthy place?
 - 3. Does not your own reflections echo hers?
- C. Her testimony shared where He brought her: the banqueting house

II. The believer's reflection on what Jesus showed

- A. Though the nature of the 'banner' is unclear, the message is crystal clear
 - 1. God's essence is love (1 John 4:8; Eph. 3:18-19)
 - 2. What is so beautiful about God's love?
- B. Meditate upon some details of this *Banner of Love*
 - 1. The Banner proclaims I have paid the price
 - 2. The Banner displays His robe of righteous and sanctification
 - 3. The Banner reassures of $His\ everlasting\ covenant\ of\ peace$
 - 4. The Banner reminds of the rest that is waiting
 - 5. The Banner trumpets forth hope in midst of our all battles
 - 6. The Banner points forward to rivers of divine pleasures
