Intro: The question is valid: Which books belong in the Bible?

A. Our life depends upon the answer: Deut. 32:44-47; 4:2; Rev. 22:19

- B. God determined and guided the process of what Books came in the Bible
 - 1. He began the 'writing of His Word' (Ex. 31:18)
 - 2. He used other writers to compose the Bible: Deut. 31:24; Joshua 24:26 etc.
 - 3. He guided His sheep who heard His voice in the Scriptures: John 10:27
- C. Then why do we find Art 6 in our confession of faith?

The Four Characteristics of the Holy Scriptures

I. Authority: They contain the will of God

II. Clarity: They contain clearly what man ought to believe
 III. Necessity They only contain what we need to know and believe
 IV. Sufficiency They contain all God wants us to know to worship Him

I. THE AUTHORITY OF THE HOLY SCRIPTURES

- A. Authority means the Bible is God stating His will to us (see art 5 & 7)
 - 1. All what Bible says is "Thus saith the LORD" (Deut. 18:18)
 - a. consider Matt. 1:22; 4:4; 19:5
 - b. consider Acts 1:16, 2:16-17
 - 2. Nowhere does Bible appeal to higher authority to establish its authority
- B. The Bible contains 'the authoritative will of God' for all mankind in all ages!
 - 1. Prov. 30:5
 - 2. John 17:17
 - 3. Gal. 6:16; Phil. 3:16
 - 4. 2 Peter 3:1-2 2 Thess 3:14
- C. Implication of the authority of Scripture:
 - 1. What does it mean to disregard disbelieve disobey the Holy Scripture?
 - 2. Where will disregarding, disbelieving, and disobeying God's Word bring us? a. meditate on Prov. 29:1; 2 Thess. 1:8-9; Heb. 12:25-29

Applications:

- A. God's promise should encourage you: Prov. 1:22-23
 - 1. God knows that without His Spirit you cannot see the truth of His Word
 - 2. God knows you *feel* the truth of His Word (Heb. 4:12)
 - a. you feel uneasy when God's Word presses is
 - on our unwillingness in God's sowing days: John 5:40
 - on our coming judgment at God's harvest day: Acts 24:25

- 3. God knows you cannot see His glory: 1 Cor. 2:14
- ${\bf 4.\ To\ encourage\ us,\ God\ promises\ His\ Spirit\ upon\ your\ obedience:\ Prov.\ 1:23}$
 - a. don't disregard, disbelieve or disobey His direction
 - b. instead strive (Greek: agonize) to enter in (Luke 13:24)
 - c. pray with expectation in faith in His promises like Ps. 81:10

 Open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it
 - d. come to His Word after wrestling in prayer like Ps. 85:8

 I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for HE will speak peace unto His people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to

folly

e. persevere in the Word like 2 Peter 1:19

We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark pace, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts.
