I. He sent us Jesus to give II. He exalted Jesus to give

I. THE GOD OF OUR FATHERS RAISED UP JESUS

- A. The God of our fathers is our God (Deut. 7:6-9; John 1:3, 10-11; Romans 11)
- B. For the God of our fathers sent us Jesus on a mission of give in love!
 - 1. He raised up Jesus (Acts 5:30; 13:22, 23; Luke 1:69)
 - 2. He sent Jesus on HIS Divine mission (John 1:14, 18; Rom. 8:3; John 10:10)
- C. The God of our fathers sent Jesus to our fathers and us: John 1:10-11
 - 1. His own didn't look very pretty: Acts 5:17, 21, 33
 - 2. His own still don't look very pretty
- D. To understand the Gospel, we need to look into the heart of God
 - 1. What did we do with God? (Genesis 3; Deut. 10:15; Amos 3:2)
 - 2. What did we make God 'feel'? (Gen. 6:6; Hosea 1-2)
 - 3. How did God act? (Gen. 3:8; Prov. 8:23; John 3:16)
 - 4. What did/do you do with God's Jesus? (John 1:11; Acts 3:13-15; 5:30)
- E. To taste the sweetness of the Gospel, taste the bitterness of your deeds!

II. THE GOD OF OUR FATHERS EXALTED JESUS TO GIVE

- A. God did not just exalt Jesus to His right hand: He did with His right hand!
 - 1. The one we slew with wicked hands He exalted with His right hand
 - 2. Indeed, let it ring in your ear, He is now LORD of Lords you will meet a. Hear the Holy Spirit's testimony: Acts 2:36; 3:20; 4:11; 5:31
 - b. Hear a truth you might have missed: Eph. 2:17; Gal. 3:1
 - c. Ponder a truth you will face: 2 Cor. 5:10-11
- B. Gladly there is a Gospel in text: He is not yet sitting on the judgment throne
 - 1. God exalted Him to a *Prince & Savior* with another Gospel task: to give!
 - 2. Don't miss it: the God of our fathers gave Him this new mission!
 - 3. Why this new mission? What does this tell you about your God?
- C. What does God want you to do?
 - 1. To repent and to believe so you can receive forgiveness (Acts 3:19)
 - 2. If you can't perform that, then He calls you to come to Jesus Christ Whom He has commissioned to give you what you need
 - 3. To encourage you to come, He promises His Holy Spirit to those who obey Him: vs. 32b; 2:38-39; John 4:10, 14; 7:37-38
