- A. The portrait of Joseph in Gen. 37:1-11
  - 1. He was not shy to work as shepherd (vs. 1-2)
  - 2. Yet his work environment was far from beautiful: vs. 2
  - 3. God gave him two mysterious dreams he shared (5-11)

## STANDING UP FOR GOD

I. It is a calling II. It is costly

- I. Standing up for God is our calling
- A. Joseph understood the calling of life: to glorify God and enjoy Him forever
  - 1. Picture him working side by side with his half-brothers (vs. 2)
    - a. what they did
    - b. what this did to Joseph (Ps. 119:136)
  - 2. What to do in those situations when we see or witness sin?
    - a. what we might feel like doing
    - b. what Joseph did in our direction
- B. Our calling is to stand up for God (Dan. 1, 3; Heb. 11:24-27)

II. The cost for standing up for God  A. Opening your mouth for God & fighting for Him comes with high cost  1. Joseph's relationship with his siblings did not flourish: why?
2. Joseph spilled his heart to his father (vs. 2)  a. he was not a tattle-taler but a burdened soul that cannot be hidden
b. charity is not always to cover sin
B. Count the cost  1. The hatred Joseph's met was for the Gospel sake (Gen. 3:15)
2. Every Christian should expect this: John 7:7; Matt. 10:34-39
C. Remember Jesus' promise: Matt. 10:32-33
Two closing reflections: A. Be not afraid when you speak up for God: 1 Peter 3:8-18

B. Keep your eyes on Jesus: 1 Peter 2:20-23
