Intro:

- A. Though the catechism treats prayer last, it is first in salvation
- B. While we get into a praying mode Satan will get into fighting mode
- C. Yet there is something that hinders prayer more than Satan

THE 5TH PETITION

I. What 5th confesses? II. What 5th asks? III. What 5th reveals?

I. What the 5TH CONFESSES?

- A. It confesses we need forgiveness daily even as saints of God
 - 1. The upright heart will sense sin in praying petition 1-4
 - 2. Yet the reality of daily sin need not destroy communion with God
- B. It confesses that we believe there is forgiveness with God: Ps. 86:5; 130; Is. 55; Jonah 4:2; Micah 7:18

II. WHAT WE ASK FOR IN THE 5TH?

- A. We ask for forgiveness of our sins and debts
 - 1. Not just our past sins but our present ones that 'cleave to us'
 - 2. We ask Him for sake of Christ's merits on cross (blood) to 'forgive'
 - a. God promised to do this instantly: 1 John 1:9; Luke 23:43
 - b. He promised to do this continually: Is. 55:7-9 ... Luke 17:4
 - c. He promised to do this whole-heartedly: Is. 43:25; Micah 7:18; Lk. 15
- B. We ask to know His forgiveness through faith in His promises (Ps. 61:2 51:12)

III. WHAT 5TH CLOSING WORDS REVEAL?

A. This does not reveal that God's act of forgiveness is dependent on us

- B. What do these words reveal?
 - 1. that we have a firm resolution from the heart to forgive our neighbors
 - 2. that we have forgiven with our heart the confessed sins of others to you a. think not cheap shallow about such the act of forgiveness
 - b. Luke 17:5 is the only power by which this is possible!
 - 3. that we have tried to seek out the offended and offending saint/sinner a. Luke 17:3-4 (you are the offended) Matt. 5:24 (you are the offender)
 - b. all sins that harm your relationship needs uncovering & confrontation
- C. These words is breathed in truth reveal God's saving grace
