Scripture: The Law of God (Ex. 20) & Jeremiah 3

Singing: 200:1, 3 – 40:5-6 – 324:1-4 – 175:3-4 – 110:1-3

Matt. 13:52: Then said he unto them, Therefore every scribe which is instructed unto the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man that is a householder, which bringeth forth out of his treasure things **new and old.**

- A. Mark 7:31-37 speaks directly to those still deaf and unable to speak
 - 1. We plunged ourselves into the deepest misery
 - 2. This condition is not just *unfortunate:* it is incriminating!
 - 3. What to do if you observe this condition in yourself?
- B. Mark 7:31-37 also speaks to God's backsliding saints

The Backsliding Saint

I. How is backsliding revealed? II. How is the backsliding saint healed?

I. How is backsliding in the saints revealed?

- A. All God's children are saints: 1 Cor. 1:2; 2 Cor. 1:1
- B. Saints are sinners 'set apart' to glorify God in a changed life (Ezek. 36:26)
- C. The life of the saint on the way to glory is a battle of flesh and spirit (Gal. 5:16)
 - 1. The wish and expectation may be to be never deaf or slow to speak
 - 2. Yet reality is that saints can become tone-deaf with silent lips (Ps. 51:15)
- D. Becoming 'deaf to sin and silent about God' is the backsliding
 - 1. Saints may continue to hear 'sin' in the gross and bold sins
 - 2. But do we still hear 'sin' in how God defines sin?
 - a. example of 'respectable or acceptable' (minor) sins
 - b. are we still thinking about God's definition of sin: missing the mark?
- E. The backsliding saint has re-defined some sin as 'little or acceptable'
 - 1. Yet to Jesus all 'sin is sin' no matter how small
 - 2. Though we may have become tone-deaf to our sins, God is not deaf!

II. How is backsliding healed?

- A. There is but one way to be healed: return to God in Christ: Jer 3:1; 4:1
 - 1. Labor at His feet for His healing touch on your conscience
 - a. revival (renewal) always begins with repentance

- 2. God gives ample encouragement to return to Him: a. Jer. 3:12 – 3:22 – Hos. 13:9 followed with 14:1 & 4
- B. Go into your inner chamber with prayers like Ps. 26:2; 139:23-24
 - 1. Plead with Him to give you a spiritual x-ray again
 - 2. Beg Him to sense serious of sin for yourself and others (Eph. 4:29)
 - 3. Rest not till your tongue be touched with the warm and unrestrained testimony of Mark 7:36-37

Close: 'If the shoe doesn't fit this morning' remember to praise Him!
