# I. The proof or evidence of the Holy Spirit's indwelling

- A. Someone living in your house will be known "by the fruits'
- B. Having the Spirit of Jesus dwelling in you is also known 'by the fruits'
  - 1. Outward evidence: a walking after the Spirit (Rom. 8:1, 4)
  - 2. Inward evidence:
    - a. being freed from the law of sin and death (Rom. 8:2, 4, 6)
    - b. having the mind of Spirit (Rom. 8:5-6, 8)
    - c. having the effects of such minding (Rom. 8:6)
  - 3. These outward & inward marks proof that there is Divine life in you!
- C. What are proofs that you have the Spirit of Him that raised Jesus dwell in you?
  - 1. No proof is (1 Cor. 13:1-3)
    - a. Knowing many Bible verses
    - b. Being active in church things
    - c. Having gift to answer difficult Bible questions
    - d. Being quiet, nice, and caring person
  - 2. Real proof is
    - a. a deep hatred/grief about sin (Ps. 38:6-8)
    - b. hunger & thirst to be and do right before and to God (Matt. 5:6)
    - c. love for God which known by its actions (1 Cor. 13:4-8)
    - d. longings and love for the Lord Jesus (John 6:68-69; 21:15-17)
    - e. humility (Ex 3:11; 1 Chron. 17:16)
    - f. conviction of "I need Thee" (Ps. 62:1)
    - g. love for others (Matt. 8:5-6)

# II. The promise of the indwelling of the Spirit

- A. The promise is that the best of your life is still to come
  - 1. To have the Spirit dwell in us *now* is beautiful but not the end of the battle a. Gal. 5:16-17
  - 2. Yet His indwelling has the promise for the future: our mortal bodies raised
    - a. 1 Cor. 15:42-44; Phil. 3:21; 1 John 3:1-3

### III. The purchase of the indwelling of the Spirit

- A. The indwelling of the Spirit was bought by Jesus: Heb. 9:12-14
  - 1. "Do this in remembrance of Me" (John 12:27-28)
  - 2. Why did Jesus need to go into this depth of hell on the cross?

    a. to purchase our redemption including the Holy Spirit's gift (Rom 8:3-4)
    - all our spiritual blessings are given in Christ (Eph. 1:3)
- B. Therefore Paul goes on to remind the 'brethren' of their debt (Rom. 8:12ff)
