I. REVIEW GOD'S 1ST AUTOBIOGRAPHY

- A. Are we making more efforts to take God's 1st Autobiography off your shelf?
 - 1. Consider God's appeal to His 1st Book: Jer 5:20-24
 - 2. Consider God's saints: Neh. 9:5-6; Ps. 8:4-5; Is. 40; Jer. 10:6, 11-13
 - 3. Where/when is this best done?
 - a. by walking in 'God's Book' (Ps. 8; 104)
 - b. by using aids to study His 1st Book (Job 38-41)
 - c. in your family worship time (Deut. 6:7)
- B. Ignorance and lack of worship of God is sin: Romans 1:20-21; 2:1-4; 15-16
- C. Due to our sin, God's 1st Autobiography is insufficient (Canons ¾, art 4)

II. GOD'S SECOND AUTOBIOGRAPHY: THE BOOK OF REVELATION

- A. There are many things not written in God's 1st Autobiography
 - 1. His Book of Creation/Providence provide us a 'glimpse' (Job 26:14)
 - 2. His 2nd Book of Revelation: *He reveals Himself more clearly and fully to us*
 - a. Book of Revelation is still limited but sufficient
 - b. Book of Revelation are like 'glasses' to read the 1st Book
 - c. Book of Revelation proclaim Himself by His WORDs while the Book of Creation declares Him by His WORKS
 - see Ps. 19; 29; 92:5
- B. Though the 2nd Book are like 'glasses' (Calvin) they are far more
 - 1. God reveals *the mystery* unrevealed in His 1st Autobiography (Rom. 16:25; 1 Cor. 2:7)
 - 2. Few examples:
 - a. God vs. Jesus
 - b. God's eternal power and godhead vs. God's character
 - c. God (Elohim; Almighty) vs. LORD (Covenant God)
 - d. God's Law vs. God's Gospel
 - e. Sense of need to pacify God vs. provision of atonement

b. What is our response to so great and gracious a blessing? (Ps. 103:7)
c. How shall we escape this Gift of God?
C. Why did God give us His Special Revelation in His 2nd Autobiography?
a. Not for *information* purposes (knowledge)
b. But for *His glory* (worship) and our salvation (relationship)
