Intro: God's autobiographies and God's biographies all reveal Him and His glory

- A. One short but notable biography: Anna the prophetess
  - 1. One unique feature of the Bible: it restores women to dignity

## GOD'S WORKER ANNA

I. Her training II. Her serving

## I. Her life training as God's worker

- A. The Holy Spirit's recorded her short biography
  - 1. she is truly a *golden* oldie who weathered many storms (vs. 36-37a)
  - 2. why are these details supplied by HS in her biography? (Romans 5:3-4)
- B. Though her story is short, her journey was long!
  - 1. God ploughed a deep and abiding furrow in her life
  - 2. God's testimony calls our attention to a greatly blessed woman
    - a. the meaning of her name is the secret of her life
    - b. her life testimony is to be the prayer-point for young and old women
    - c. the testimony of the first Christian women in the world is inspiring

## II. Her life of serving as God's worker

- A. God trained her to be a prophetess despite sad family roots (vs. 36)
  - 1. family roots: tribe of Aser
  - 2. prophetess: how to understand this? (Ex. 15:20; Judges 4:4; 2 Kings 22:14)
  - 3. her serving of God with fastings and prayers night and day (37b)
    - a. the main matter of her exercise: the coming Messiah (Dan. 9:24-27)
  - 4. her worship of the LORD God for Jesus Christ (vs. 38)
    - a. the highest worship of God is thanksgiving gift of His Son (vs. 38)
    - b. how do I know the same Holy Spirit is within me?
      - by how you sense the personal need for redemption!
      - by your heart longs for God's salvation (Luke 2:30)
      - by your growing understanding of glory of Jesus
      - by your thanksgiving like Simeon for His salvation (28, 38)

- 5. her witness about Jesus Christ to all seekers for redemption (38b)
  - a. Anna knew not everyone was interested in her testimony
  - c. Anna received perhaps 'one glimpse' and it sufficed her heart!

**Take-away:** Let our women aspire to be prophetesses & prayer-warriors! A. God has equipped women differently than men

- B. Yet let not this gift degenerate into the sin Paul rebukes: 1 Tim. 5:13
  - 1. Strive in prayer to have prayers like Anna
  - 2. Strive in prayer to have tongues like Anna
