I. What this meant for Jesus Christ? II. What does this mean for each believer?

I. WHAT THIS EXCHANGE MEANT FOR CHRIST?

A. The Father made Jesus 'sin for us'

1. Observe that the Father did this to Jesus (Ezek. 33:11)

- 2. Observe how He paved the way back: he hath made Jesus sin for us
- B. What did this mean for Christ?
 - 1. It filled Him with indescribable horror: Matt. 26:36-38; Lk 22:42-44
 - 2. Yet this exchange also was His indescribable joy: Ps. 40:8 a. His love constraint Him to do His Father's will
 - b. His love constraint Him to do this for His bride (Gen. 29:20; John 15:11-13)

II. WHAT DID THIS EXCHANGE MEAN FOR US?

- A. It provided what each born-again soul hungers/thirsts after: righteousness in Him!
 - 1. God **declares** that to him that worketh not, believeth on Him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. (Rom. 4:5)
 - 2. God calls us to believe Him trust His truthful promise (Lord's Day 23)
- B. Why is it so hard to believe and to rejoice in Gospel truth?
