Introduction: A woman on a mission: Luke 7:37

A. Her actions speak of her genuine love – faith – hope in Jesus

- B. Jesus' teaching indicate she missed the "full assurance of hope" (Heb. 6:11)
  - 1. This is not an uncommon condition among believers in Jesus
    - a. some think their sins are too great to be forgiven
    - b. some struggle with deep shame and uncleanness
    - c. some feel it humbler to doubt

## JESUS' SERMON TO A PENITENT SINNER

- I. His reassuring words of pardon II. His encouraging words of direction
- I. His reassuring words of pardon: Thy sins are forgiven thy faith saved thee
- A. Jesus' prophetic ministry illustrates the 'use of the keys of Kingdom'
  - 1. What He said to her, He speaks to all who come to Him in faith: HC. 31.84
  - 2. Compare God's Testimonies: Luke 8:48; John 5:24; Acts 10:43; 13:38-39; Eph. 1:7; 1 John 1:9
  - 3. Hear Jesus' reassuring message: she was a great sinner but forgiven!
- B. Notice that Jesus did not do this indiscriminately with everyone
  - 1. He declares His forgiveness to those who come to Him in faith: vs. 50a!
  - 2. Yet observe Jesus did not declare this to the woman in John 8:11

## II. His encouraging words of direction: go in peace!

- A. Peace is one of the most important truths in the Bible
  - 1. Entire main theme of Bible is peace!
    - a. God calls Himself the God of peace (Rom. 15:33; 16:20; 1 Thess 5:23)
    - b. God is on mission of Shalom: Luke 2:14 Eph. 2:17
    - c. God's redemption work will triumph into universal shalom: Is. 11:6-9
  - 2. "Peace" (shalom) applies to all relationships
    - a. Peace with God infinite/eternal peace: Rom. 5:1; Eph.2:16-17
    - b. Peace with fellow men: Heb. 12:14; Rom. 14:19
    - c. Peace within yourself: Col. 3:15; Phil. 4:7
- B. Jesus directed her to 'go into this peace with God' (Romans 5:1)
  - 1. This 'peace with God' is an objective *fact* that will be a *subjective feeling* upon embracing the benefit: Rom. 15:13
  - 2. Jesus summoned her to 'get up and go into peace' (vs. 50; John 14:27)

## **TAKE-ALONG APPLICATIONS:**

- A. What did the Lord Jesus remind His believing people of?
  - 1. That the more you look away from Him, the less peace you will have!
  - 2. That you need to 'go into peace' and be like David in Ps. 42:5 11; 103:1-5
- B. What did the Lord Jesus proclaim to you still dead in trespasses and sin?
  - 1. That God comes to you and calls you as the God of peace!
